Ryan Lackey

Ryan Lackey has been a cypherpunk for over 20 years. He founded the world's first offshore datahaven, HavenCo, on Sealand in 2000. He was involved with pre-cryptocurrency anonymous digital currencies backed with gold and other assets, and worked in Iraq, Afghanistan, and other conflict zones, bootstrapping a satellite and wireless communications company. Later, he founded a Y Combinator-backed startup, CryptoSeal, which he sold to Cloudflare in 2014. After working at Cloudflare for the following two years, he founded ResetSecurity, a travel security company, in 2016.

Ivan Fratric

Ivan Fratric is a member of Google Project Zero where he works on security research, currently mainly focusing on web browser security. Before that, he was a member of the Google Security Team where he was a tech lead for security reviews of Google products. Prior to joining Google, he was a research and teaching assistant at the Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing at the University of Zagreb where he received his PhD in 2011. He is credited for the discovery of dozens of high-risk security vulnerabilities in commonly used software products. He is the author of WinAFL (Windows version of AFL fuzzer) and ROPGuard (A tool for detecting ROP attacks which won the second prize in the Microsoft BlueHat contest in 2012 and is integrated in Microsoft EMET).

Arnim Eijkhoudt

Arnim Eijkhoudt works at KPN-CERT, part of the CISO team of KPN Telecom in the Netherlands. He joined KPN in 2016 after a career in academia, where he lectured on and researched digital forensics and information security. As one of KPN-CERT's incident responders, he is primarily focusing on threat intel, digital forensic investigations and punching miscreants. Arnim's talk title is: From Incident to Threat Response.
